STANDING ORDER RE: MOTIONS FOR PROTECTIVE ORDERS IN CRIMINAL CASES

In criminal cases before this session where the government is seeking a protective order to protect confidential or other sensitive information contained in discovery materials, any proposed stipulated protective order must contain the following provision:

When providing protected discovery materials to third parties, defense counsel or his or her agent must inform the person that the materials are provided subject to the terms of this Protective Order and that the person must comply with the terms of this Protective Order, and the person to whom such protected discovery materials are provided must sign an acknowledgement to be bound by the terms of the Protective Order.
